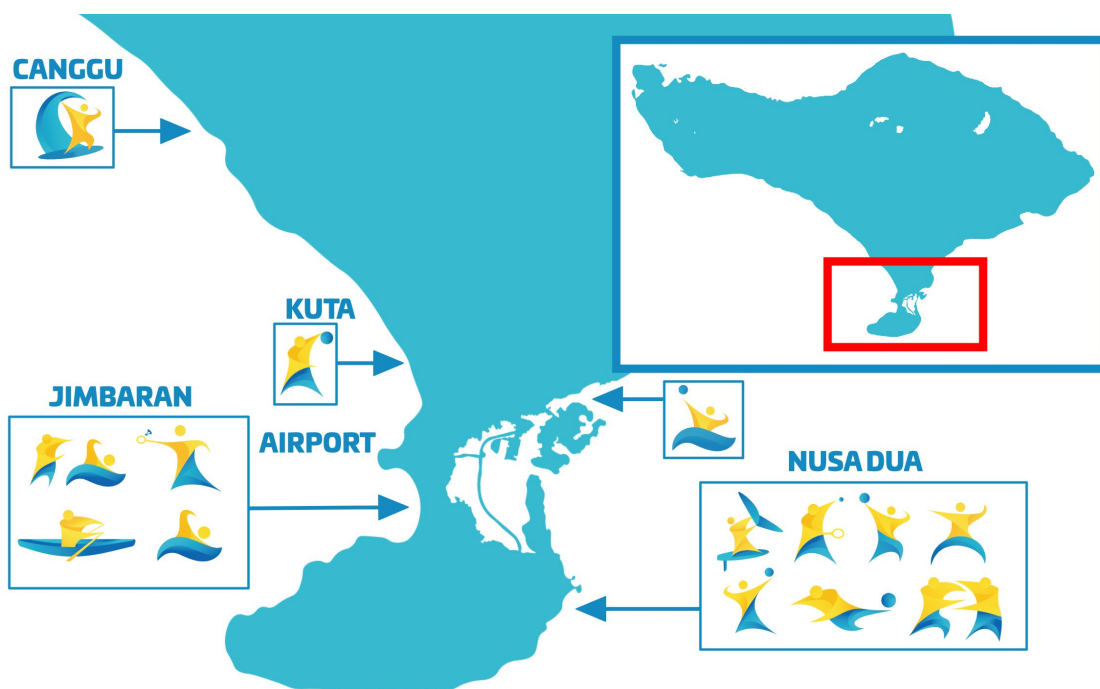

### 3. MEDIA ACCREDITATION PROCESS

All media representatives are invited to fill the accreditation registration form through the following link: [Click here to register.](#)

Please note that the Games Management System is optimized for **Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox** and **Safari**. For compatibility reasons, we recommend that you use any of these browsers to access the system. Be aware that if you use a different web browser some features may vary.

Accreditation registration is open for international media (organizations outside Indonesia) from May 10<sup>th</sup> 2023 to June 27<sup>th</sup> 2023. All requests received will be submitted for validation of the respective National Olympic Committee, according to the country the media organization is based.

Accreditation for national media (organizations based in Indonesia) will be open from May 10<sup>th</sup> 2023 to August 1<sup>st</sup> 2023. All requests received from national media will be validated by NOC Indonesia.

**Media accreditation will be divided in three categories:**

1. E / Ep : print, digital, photographers, and Sports Organization media
2. ENR: non-rights holders radio and tv, and content creators (influencers, bloggers, podcasters, youtubers)
3. RHB: rights holder broadcasters

Content creator applicants will be requested to submit further information including but not limited to social media account and coverage plan. These applications will be validated by the LOC Marketing and Broadcasting functional areas.

Accreditation collection will take place from August 1<sup>st</sup> to August 12<sup>th</sup> at the Nusa Dua Main Accreditation Centre.

**IMPORTANT: Media accreditation does not grant right to broadcast or stream live any official event of AWBG Bali 2023.**

For media organization willing to broadcast or stream live the 2<sup>nd</sup> ANOC World Beach Games Bali2023, a formal request of rights shall be directed and negotiated with: [mela.sabina@bali2023.id](mailto:mela.sabina@bali2023.id) and [linda.wahyudi@bali2023.id](mailto:linda.wahyudi@bali2023.id).

## 4. PLANNING YOUR TRIP: HEALTH, VISA AND CUSTOM DECLARATION REQUIREMENTS

The Accreditation card will not function as a visa and will not authorise entry into the Republic of Indonesia. Hence, the Accreditation card will not be sent out to any participant before the 2nd ANOC World Beach Games Bali 2023.

**Each individual will be responsible for ensuring they have the travel documents needed to enter the Republic of Indonesia and, if applicable, for obtaining a valid visa at their own cost.** This includes preparing, delivering and collecting any documents required before and after the visa application process.

### 4.1. VACCINATION CERTIFICATE

When checking in for the flight to the Republic of Indonesia, one **must** present a vaccination certificate proving that they have been **fully vaccinated** against COVID-19. International travellers can show proof of vaccination in English, both in digital or hard copy. Please find all the vaccination information [here](#) (scroll down the page for the English version. Please note that during certain days this page might be offline).

One is considered **fully vaccinated**:

- a. two (2) weeks (14 days) after your dose of the accepted single-dose vaccine (Johnson & Johnson)
- b. two (2) weeks (14 days) after your second dose of the accepted 2-dose vaccine (Pfizer, Moderna, Sinovac, AstraZeneca, and Sinopharm)

**IMPORTANT:** Please note that those who are unable to provide proof of vaccination **will not be allowed to enter** the Republic of Indonesia. Neither ANOC nor the Bali 2023 Organizing Committee will be responsible if a participant is refused entry or to board an airplane to the Republic of Indonesia because of failure to provide a valid COVID-19 certificate or proof of vaccination.

ANOC highly recommends that all participants check the latest health and travel requirements imposed by airlines or transit countries before departure. Missed flights, accommodation, or testing costs arising from being unable to provide proof of vaccination will not be refunded by ANOC or the Bali 2023 Organizing Committee.

### 4.2 VISA

**Every participant** who travels to Bali for the event **must apply for an entry visa**, except 9 ASEAN Countries depending on the media representative's nationality, a different type of visa must be considered.

## A. VISA-FREE:

Nationals of the **9 ASEAN countries** (see the list below) are eligible for visa-free entry to the Republic of Indonesia (**maximum** duration of stay is **30 days**).

To enter the Republic of Indonesia, nationals of these countries **must**:

- hold a passport that is valid for at least **six (6) months** from the date of arrival to the Republic of Indonesia.
- have a hard copy of a return or onward ticket that indicates the date of departure from the Republic of Indonesia.
- provide a valid COVID-19 certificate or proof of vaccination (please refer to the section above for vaccination requirements).
- have downloaded and installed the SATUSEHAT app on a mobile phone (available on [Google Play](#) and the [App Store](#))

## B. ELECTRONIC VISA (E-VOA):

Nationals of **77 countries** (see the list below) are eligible to apply for their electronic visa (E-VOA) **online** before travelling to the Republic of Indonesia. The E-VOA is a **single-entry visa** with a **maximum** duration of stay of **30 days**, extendable once for another 30 days. The visa has a cost of IDR 500.000,00 (approx. USD\$ 35) which can be paid by credit or debit card with Visa, MasterCard, or JCB Network. **Each participant shall be in charge of such cost .**

Nationals of these countries **must** submit their E-VOA application **online** before travelling to Bali, Indonesia. E-VOA applications must be done **14 days** and **not later than 48 hours** before departing the home country.

Each participant will receive an Information Document from ANOC containing the necessary information for the online application. Please take note of the instructions below to submit your online E-VOA application:

- Step 1.** Use the following [link](#) to access the online application.
- Step 2.** Before submitting the E-VOA, create an Account by “Main Page > Apply > Register” (please note that each E-VOA must be submitted by the respective account) and:
  - a) Fill in the data
  - b) Receive a verification email
  - c) Activate the Account by clicking “activate” on the verification email (must be confirmed within one hour)
- Step 3.** After logging in to your account, you can apply for e-VOA by clicking “Main Page > Apply”
- Step 4.** Have the following to complete the application, please note that all digital documents must be in JPG/JPEG, size between 100-400kb:
  - a) copy of the passport's data page (passport must be valid for at least 6 (six) months from the date of arrival to the Republic of Indonesia)

- b) electronic passport-size photograph (face facing forward, white background), size 4x6 cm with a resolution of at least 400x600 pixels
- c) valid email address (issued E-VOA will be sent to that email address)
- d) valid Mastercard, Visa, or JCB credit or debit card (the card is not required to be under the applicant's name, but must have a "3D Secure System" and be open to international transactions)

**Step 5.** As your destination, please enquire your hotel about the exact address, including Province, City, District, Village and Postal Code.

**Step 6.** Once the E-VOA is issued and sent by email, participants must print it out and have it ready to present at the check-in counter departing to Bali and when entering the Republic of Indonesia

To enter the Republic of Indonesia, nationals that are eligible for E-VOA **must**:

- b. present a printed copy of their E-VOA.
- c. present a hard copy of a return or onward ticket that indicates the date of departure from the Republic of Indonesia.
- d. provide a valid COVID-19 certificate or proof of vaccination.
- e. have downloaded and installed the SATUSEHAT app on a mobile phone (available on [Google Play](#) and the [App Store](#))

### C. SINGLE ENTRY VISITOR VISA – EMBASSY APPLICATION

Nationals of **119 countries** (see the list below will need to apply for a Single Entry Visitor Visa to enter the Republic of Indonesia at the accredited Indonesian Embassy to their country/territory. The Single Entry Visitor Visa allows a **maximum** duration of stay between **30 - 60 days**. ANOC and the Indonesian Olympic Committee will provide a Visa Invitation letter upon registration to apply for the Single Entry Visitor Visa at the Indonesian embassy. **Each participant shall be in charge of such cost.**

Each participant will receive an Visa Invitation Letter from the Indonesian Olympic Committee through the GMS to support the visa application. Please take note of the instructions below to apply for a Single-Entry Visitor Visa at the embassy in your territory:

**Step 1.** Participants **must** fill out all the mandatory information on the ANOC's registration system (GMS) before the **deadline of 27 June 2023 (Important: you must enter the data of the passport you intend to travel with, passport validity should be for at least **six (6) months** from the date of arrival to the Republic of Indonesia).** The digital documents that you should prepare should be in **colour, JPG/JPEG format, size between 100kb-400kb**, are:

- a) Full biodata page of passport with at least 6 months validity from the date of your arrival to Indonesia.
- b) Passport size photograph face facing forward, size 4 x 6 cm with a resolution of at least 400 x 600 pixels
- c) Return ticket or onward ticket to continue the trip to another country

**Step 2.** ANOC will send the participant's information to the Indonesian Olympic Committee

**Step 3.** The Indonesian Olympic Committee will submit a Visa Invitation Letter on behalf of each participant through the GMS

**Step 4.** The participant needs to apply at the Indonesian embassy accredited to their country /territory with the following documents

- a) Visa Invitation letter
- b) Full biodata page of passport with at least 6 months validity from the date of your arrival to Indonesia
- c) A return ticket or onward ticket to continue the trip to another country
- d) A bank account statement (Minimum Balance of 2000USD) for the last three (3) months
- e) A Passport size photograph face facing forward, size 4 x 6 cm with a resolution of at least 400 x 600 pixels
- f) Valid COVID-19 certificate or proof of full vaccination

***Please note, that each embassy may request for additional or different documents. Therefore, we recommend getting in touch with the embassy to understand the full requirements to apply for the Single Entry Visitor Visa.***

**Step 5.** The visa approval and issuance process will take **approximately 4 weeks.**

**Step 6.** Once the visa is approved and the costs are paid, the participant will receive the Single Entry visa

To enter the Republic of Indonesia, nationals that require a Single Entry Visitor Visa **must**:

- a. hold a passport that is valid for at least six (6) months from the date of arrival to the Republic of Indonesia.
- b. present a printed copy of their Single Entry Visitor Visa.
- c. present a hard copy of a return or onward ticket that indicates the date of departure from the Republic of Indonesia.
- d. provide a valid COVID-19 certificate or proof of vaccination.
- e. have downloaded and installed the SATUSEHAT app on a mobile phone (available on [Google Play](#) and the [App Store](#))

#### 4.3. ELECTRONIC CUSTOMS DECLARATION

**Every participant** who travels to the Republic of Indonesia **must** submit an electronic customs declaration **2 days before arrival**.



Please follow the instructions below:

- a. Either scan the QR code on the image on the right or click the [link](#) to access the Electronic Customs Declaration form.
- b. Fill out the form (the information regarding the hotel and address can be found on the Information Letter)
- c. Once the form is submitted, a window confirming the receipt of the form
- d. Click on **Download QR** and once it is downloaded, please save it and have it ready to show upon arrival in Bali after Baggage claim.

## 6. MEDIA FACILITIES

### 6.1. Media Working Spaces

The Local Organizing Committee will provide the following working spaces for media:

**International Broadcasting Centre** – Ayodia Hotel, Nusa Dua

**Media seats** – 20 reserved seats in each competition venue. There will be no tabled seats in the competition venues.

MPC will start **operating** five hours before the opening ceremony and closes activity two hours after farewell party.

MPC will offer **press conference** facilities.

MPC will offer **lockers, information desk and snack corner**.

MPC will have 100mbps **internet access** (lan and wifi). Venues will offer wifi internet connection.

All competition venues will offer **mixed zone** areas.

### 6.2. Media Transport

There will be no dedicated transport for Games clients. Media will be entitled to use the Games Shuttle Service, that will run connecting Games clusters and will serve also the MPC and media hotels.

All qualified NOCs were invited to accredit one Social Media Attaché in the official delegation. This will ensure a worldwide coverage and fan engagement of the 2<sup>nd</sup> ANOC World Beach Games.

#### ***AWBG BALI2023 PHOTO PROJECT***

ANOC will support the NOCs with a team of sports-specialized photographers, that will cover 100% of the sports, 100% of the sessions and 100% of the NOCs. Twelve photographers will be on-site and the images will be made available to the media for copyright-free editorial use.

ANOC´s official OTT platform anoc.tv will feature exclusive content about the AWBG Bali 2023.

### **7.4. SOCIAL MEDIA GUIDELINES:**

AWBG Bali2023 is well connected in the digital era and therefore encourages all accredited person to share content on their social media platforms, although only media accredited as such are allowed to cover the event as journalists.

5. Short videos and Instagram/Facebook lives can be taken at official venues during the Games, lasting a maximum of 10 minutes. Including designated areas around the Field of Play. Broadcasting the competition is not allowed, however 15-second video clips for Instagram stories is permitted, considering they are not followed by another 15-second videos in the same sequence of action.

**Important:** please note that only rights holder accredited as such are allowed to broadcast live total or part of the competition.
